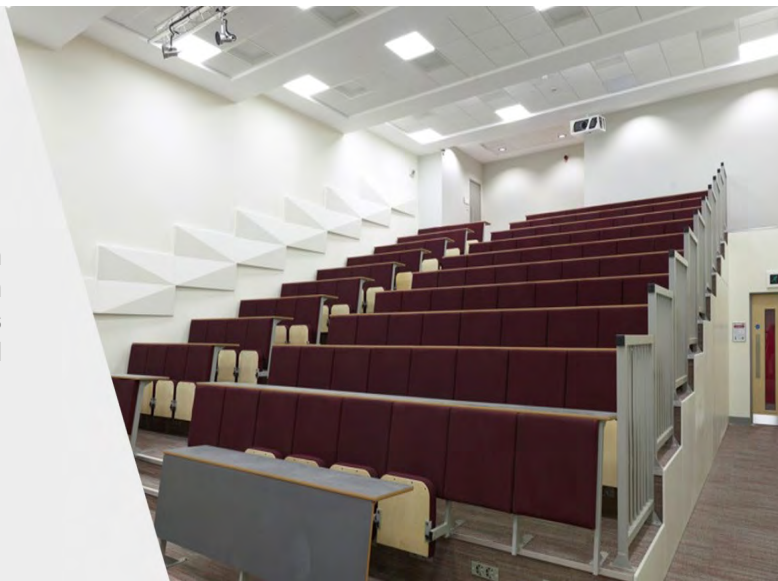




University of Central Lancashire

The Challenge

The University of Central Lancashire is the eighth largest in the UK. As part of its carbon-reduction scheme, the university wanted to standardise its lighting to a few suppliers, to ensure quality and continuity.



The Solution

Working with a digital-dimming lighting-control supplier, we have now been appointed as one of UCLAN's LED-lighting partners. We supply LED lighting to all the commercial areas on multiple campuses alongside another lighting supplier providing classroom lighting.

The Results - Per 250 Lucid 60's



By changing its current 4x18w T8 fluorescent to Allied Lucid 60 panels, the university immediately made 63% electrical-consumption savings. This, alongside the digital dimming system, will see even greater savings.

- Consultancy and Strategy** - After the UCLAN Facilities Department had identified the right areas, Allied conducted a lighting survey.
